**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
Respecting Continuation of Production**

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by and between ACTRA and _____ (the Producer) on behalf of _____ (Production Company) with respect to the _____ (type of Production) entitled _____ (title of Production).

The purpose of this Understanding is to promote labour stability in the motion picture and television industry in Canada, thereby preserving employment for Performers represented by ACTRA and continuity for Productions in the event of a lawful strike or lockout.

With respect to the above-named Production, the terms and conditions of the 2004-2006 Independent Production Agreement (IPA), to which the Producer is a signatory, shall continue in full force and effect beyond the expiry date of the 2004-2006 IPA (December 31st, 2006) until completion of Production, or December 31, 2007 (whichever is the earlier), except for the following terms which are deemed to form part of, and to amend, the IPA for the production noted above:

1. Effective January 1, 2007, there will be a general increase of 5% on all fees;
2. The Producer will contribute an additional 1% of each Performer's Gross Fees for each Performer's Insurance benefits per Article A3801, and an additional 1% of each Performer's Gross Fees for each Performer's Retirement benefits per Article A3802. The amount of Non-member Equalization Payments (per Article A3703) will also be increased by the same amounts.

For greater clarity, and despite any provision to the contrary in the IPA, or its Appendix 2 Negotiation Protocol, in the event of a lawful strike or lockout declared by any Party to the IPA following the expiry of the current IPA on December 31, 2006, the above-named Production which has executed a Voluntary Recognition Agreement and this Memorandum shall not be subject to any strike or any other labour action by ACTRA. Similarly, no Producer will lockout any Performer engaged in the above-named Production.
