Billie's Bio

Born in Ottawa, Ontario Billie started her radio career volunteering at local radio and TV stations at the age of 15. She attended Humber College where she studied both TV and Film Production and Radio Broadcasting. After taking a year to backpack through Europe she headed to Toronto to start her career.

Billie first appeared on the Toronto scene with a bang by hosting the number one Top-40 Morning Radio Show in Canada "The Mad Dog and Billie Show" on KISS 92.5FM. There, she gained her reputation as the girl who ALWAYS got the interview. From 1999 to 2004 Billie traveled to LA, NYC and Miami to bring Toronto audiences the best seats in the house for the red carpets at the Grammy's, the Billboard Awards, the MTV Awards, the People's Choice Awards, the American Music Awards and more! As soon as the award show was over, Billie brought her audience with her to the after parties filled with the biggest celebrities in the world, where she always has a way of getting "in". At The 2003 Super Bowl in San Diego, Billie was the only member of the press to be in the locker room with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers celebrating, while live on the air for KISS 92 and the FAN 590.

In 2004 Billie took over the coveted morning show position on 98.1 CHFI along with Mad Dog to host The Jay and Billie Show on CHFI 98.1 FM. After a year off, Billie joined 99.9 MIX FM to host The Mad Dog and Billie Show which airs Monday to Friday on MIX FM.

Billie is an award winning journalist, winner of "Best Morning Show-Mad Dog and Billie" by the Toronto Sun Newspaper in 2000, 2001, and 2003. Also, the show picked up NOW Magazine's "Best Of Toronto" award for best radio DJ's "Mad Dog and Billie" in 2003. Billie was also a spokesperson for COVER GIRL cosmetics for 3 years. Billie has been profiled in countless magazines and newspapers across the country.



Billie sits down with the stars to give us an always fun, laid back interview that gets the answers to the questions no one else can ask. She has done countless national interview specials for the Sound Source Network including Norah Jones, Mariah Carey, Justin Timberlake, Janet Jackson, Jennifer Lopez, Marc Anthony, Lenny Kravitz, Gwen Stefani, John Mayer, Pink and Diana Krall.

Billie's TV credits include being the female judge on season one of the highly successful POPSTARS on Global TV, a role on Show Times SOUL FOOD opposite Vaessa Williams, Degrassi Jr. High, HAIR WARS, MUCH MUSIC, MTV Canada, The Mike Bullard Show, TSN, Co-hosting DAYTIME on Rogers, Global TV's "My Fabulous Gay Wedding" and more. Most recently she hosted the Toronto 1 LIVE late night show "LAST CALL" five nights a week. The show, the first live late night talk show in Canada, allowed Billie to showcase her strengths of hosting a live show, interviewing celebrities and politicians while also having a huge role in the writing and production of the nightly show.

Billie is also dedicated to the community. In 2001 Billie started 'GO' (Girls Only). GO is a program for the Toronto District School Board where she speaks to hundreds of high school girls about self-esteem and staying strong. For her efforts in working with teenage girls Billie received the Public Education HERO Award in 2002. She has also been a spokesperson for The Canadian Breast Cancer Foundation, The Children's Cancer Society and Sheena's Place (a center for women with eating disorders). Billie is also on the board of directors for Canstage Theatre.
