Clea is a performer and a designer living in Montreal. From 2002-2005 Clea studied at France's National Puppetry School (E.S.N.A.M) located at the International Institute of Puppetry Arts, in Charleville-Mézières, France. Upon returning to Canada she has been employed as a: puppeteer, actress, puppet builder, designer, director, and teacher. She has worked in theatre companies (Ches Panses Verts, Shadowland, Jumblies), on solo performances (Oh! What a Feeling, Immobile, Pulcinella and Transgenetic Beast), in short films (ClydeHenry Productions, Amnon Buchbinder, Cie Green Ginger), music videos (So-called, The Belle Orchestre), and concerts (Feist, Patrick Watson).
