Film & Television

- Am the subject of two film documentaries about my work as an actor, musician, cabaret artist
- Dozens of Canadian, American & European TV appearances, interviewed & performing extracts of my work (CBC TV, Radio Can., Global, CTV, TVA, etc.)

- Recorded 18 albums of music where I do vocals (spoken word, poetry, monologues, etc.)
